School-wide Priorities Survey for ALL students—Your Opinion Matters to US! — September 2nd to 14th

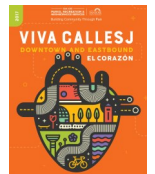

Who should attend the DACA Renewal Workshop?
If you have DACA and your work permit will expire between now and March 5, 2018, you must apply for the two-year renewal of your DACA by October 5, 2017.

What do I bring?

- Two (2) passport photos
- Copy of your earlier DACA application
- Check payable to the "US Department of Homeland Security" in the amount of \$495.00
- Copy of your DACA work permit (front and back)
- Any other supporting documents (e.g. advance parole documents, marriage certificates, etc.)
